Dear Parents,

This is a reminder that Texas State Law has changed the requirements for all children entering kindergarten and 7th grade, effective immediately. All students must have proof of complete immunizations or notarized letters of exemption in order to be allowed entrance into school.

Students entering Kindergarten must have the following shots on record:

- DTP/DTaP: total of 5 doses
- Polio: 4 doses
- Hepatitis B: 3 doses
- Hepatitis A: 2 doses
- MMR: 2 doses
- Varicella/Varivax/Chicken Pox: 2 doses (Or signed letter stating child has had chicken pox/ approximate time of illness)

Students entering 7th grade must have the following newly required shots on record:

- Td/Tetanus booster
- Varicella: 2 doses
- Meningococcal/Menactra: 1 dose

In most instances, your child has already had his/her necessary shots, but we do not have the most up-dated, current record on file at the school. If you're uncertain as to your child's immunization status, call your doctor to determine if he/she is up-to-date.

Immunization records can be faxed to THRS by you or your doctor at 281-265-7880.

Current records may also be brought to the back-to-school Orientation on Monday, 8/17/09, along with the Health History/Medication Permit paper you received by mail.
